Chelmsford Theatre Studio Technical Specification

Chelmsford Theatre Studio is an intimate black box theatre seating up to 165 and presents a programme of smaller scale professional touring theatre, music productions, dance, and lunchtime concerts. Films and live screenings come to life in the Studio with comfortable seating.

The retractable seating allows for varied seating configurations including standing, cabaret and immersive environments. The space is also available for hire for lectures, conferences and exhibitions. The retractable tiered seating unit seats 140, with an additional 2 front rows available to seat a further 26. In cabaret layout the room can accommodate up to 125.

Building Access and Get-In Arrangements:

The site is accessible from Fairfield Road, via a security barrier. Access is provided for unloading/loading only. Vehicles must exit using the Coval Lane barrier unless they are over 15 tonnes, in which case they must turn around and exit via Fairfield Road.

- The access door is 1.7m wide x 2m high
- Technical staff will need to supervise reversing of any large vehicles
- You will be able to park alongside the fire exit doors (the first set that you come to) for the purposes of unloading only
- Parking is available in nearby 'Visitor' parking spaces, or the Fairfield Road car park (access via Coval Lane)
- A door code will be given to you by your Duty
 Stage Technician for backstage access

Dressing Rooms and Backstage Facilities:

- 2 dressing rooms with adjoining door, each with 2 sinks and accommodating 12 persons per room
- The backstage corridor has a show relay video monitor screen
- Dressing rooms receive show relay and backstage calls
- Shower and toilet facilities are located along the backstage corridor

Auditorium Layouts and capacity.

- Overall size of the room with seating retracted 11x11.5m (36ft x 37ft)
- With tiered seating at 140 capacity, the maximum performance area is 11x5m (36x 16')
- With tiered seating and additional rows of seats, the capacity is 166, the maximum performance area is 11x3m (36x10')
- This is available as bare wooden floor or with fitted Harlequin cascade black dance floor

Staging:

- Staging can be used but may restrict use of front two rows of seats or cabaret capacity
- Staging is 2x1m RATStand Stage 4 aluminium deck with 2ft legs as standard.
- There are 2 pairs of soft black masking. As standard one is tracked at the rear, and one covers the side walls of the stage.
- Screwing or bolting into the stage is NOT permitted
- Please note there are no permanent tabs at the front of the stage, but swipe and 2-part tab tracks are available.

Access Equipment and Working at Height:

- Access to the grid is via a Zarges three part ladder or an A-Frame step ladder
- The tallescope may be used if the seating has been retracted and it is available
- The lighting grid is 4.87m high (16ft)

Visitors are allowed to work at height under the supervision and at the discretion of the Duty Stage Technician. Our Risk Assessments and Normal Operating Procedures are available on request.

Lighting:

- The standard operating position for all performances is in the control room at the rear of the seating bank

- ETC Ion XE20 lighting desk with 1 touchscreen
- ETC remote app on an iPad

Dimming and Universes

- 106 dimmer circuits from Light Processor Dimension dimmers
- (90 hardwired to 15a sockets, 12 hard patchable to 4 socapex outlets, DMX LED houselights and projection screen wash)
- DMX circuits are available in the lighting rig and are patched in the control room via a splitter unit
- All intelligent fixtures will appear on universe 2

Power

- All theatrical lighting uses 15-amp plugs and sockets
- Some 13 and 16 amp sockets are available from facility panels located around the theatre
- 1 x 63 amp single phase CEE form socket is available USR

Lantern Stock

The venue operates a standard LX rig. This is a multipurpose LX rig designed to provide front wash light, 3 colour wash using parcans and backlight and several specials. Your individual lighting requirements can be arranged for you in advance or on the day of your arrival on provision of a detailed venue specific lighting plan. Please contact us if required. This equipment is shared between theatres and may not be available.

- For cabaret style seating, a sound desk can also be set up at floor level. This must be agreed before the show goes on sale as it requires the removal of seats from sale
